

Desktop Publishing Brochures

Shown here is a template for designing an 8¹/₂x11 six-panel brochure. The extra-wide 3 pica margins allow the brochure to be printed on most desktop printers. If you have access to a better printer, try 2 pica margins for a better fit with long text passages.

Tips

In Quark, set picas as the horizontal and vertical unit of measurement in Edit, General Preferences. This allows you to quickly set up your page margins with the dimensions given. Remember that there are 6 picas per inch, and there are 12 points/pica.

The fold line locations are unequal to allow for proper folding. The Flap is smaller than the Cover so that it fits completely inside when folded. This means that the columns are unequal in width, and you should make manual text frames instead of relying on Quark's automatic column feature. Use the Linking tool to flow text from frame to frame. Also, be sure to uncheck the Automatic Text Box feature when setting up your page.
